


Two reasons for choice (factors)

Week 3	On the third week I started to cut out the gett for the backround. I stuck gip the gelt using bond web. I also stillned the E. A and Rip pink enbrokery thread. (In backs tip h).
	on the forth week I stitched the out of the backround fabric using an invisable stich and two different colours of blue thred. I also stiched the Sin pink enbrodery thred. (In backstith).



Week 5	on the fifth week sketched the outline of the polar bear onto the selt using taylors, chalk, I then sticked the outside of the polar bear using white thred. Finally I sticked on the pelt lee-busing an invisable stick.


Creativity and design
